CONSTITUTION OF THE BOYS' TOWN ALUMNI

Article III – OBJECTS

Its objects are as follows:

- 1) to create, foster and maintain a feeling of friendship, unity and co-operation among past pupils of Boys' Town;
- 2) to bring them, staff and ex-staff of Assumption English School, Assumption Vocational Institute and Boys' Town Home into closer touch with their Alma Mater and the Brothers of St Gabriel;
- 3) to raise and administer fund for scholarships and other worthy causes that benefits the stakeholders of the Alumni;
- 4) to organise activities that are conducive to promote social and intellectual behavior

Article IV – MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to the following categories:

- 1 **Ordinary Members:** The membership for Ordinary Members shall be opened to all ex-pupils pupils of Boys' Town, Assumption English School and Assumption Vocational Institute. Students in Secondary, Junior College or Centralised Institute should join as Associate members with no voting rights and that they should not pay any subscription fee.
- 2 **Life Members:** They shall be confined only to ordinary members upon payment of a lump sum subscription of \$100/- (Dollars One Hundred). They shall enjoy the full rights and privileges of ordinary members;
- 3 **Honorary Members & Advisors:** They shall be confined to the Director of Boys' Town and the current principals of Assumption English School and Assumption Vocational Institute or person appointed by the Director, Boys' Town to act as advisor. They shall not have any voting rights, hold office, or have any say in the management of the Alumni;
- 4 **Patron:** The Patrons shall be nominated and approved by the Executive Committee. They shall not have any vote, hold office, or have any say in the management of the ALUMNI nor shall they act in any advisory capacity;
- 5 **Associate Members:** They shall be confined to the staff or ex-staff of Boys' Town, Assumption English School or Assumption Vocational Institute who are not past pupils of the schools upon a lump sum payment of \$50 as Associate Membership fee.

A person wishing to join the ALUMNI shall submit his application in writing on a form to be supplied by the ALUMNI. The Honorary Secretary shall, on receipt of the said application for membership, submit the same for approval to the Executive Committee, who shall have power to approve or reject such application without assigning any reason whatsoever.

Article V – ENTRANCE FEE

There shall be no Entrance Fee

Article VI - SUBSCRIPTION

- 1) Ordinary members shall pay a yearly subscription of \$10.00 (Dollars Ten),
- 2) Any member owing subscription for more than three years shall be duly informed of the said arrears by the Honorary Secretary. If no payment is made after the notification, his name shall be struck off the Register of Names and he shall not be eligible for re-application for membership unless his application has been approved by the Executive Committee..
